

ANIME-KAO KIGURUMI MASK PURCHASE ORDER AND AGREEMENT FORM Rev.1.2

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1. Mask usage information for buyer (Read first)

Mask usage

- The kigurumi mask is a piece of artwork so it is extremely delicate and should be treated with care. Do not allow the mask to hit objects. It is not a helmet. Any damages will be solely the mask owner's responsibility.
- Even though the mask is made from fibre glass which is a very tough material, the mask is very rigid and may break when dropped or impacted. The owner must make sure to never drop the mask. Under normal usage, the structure is highly durable.
- As the mask is painted, it is vulnerable to scratching. Extreme care must be taken that sharp or hard objects do not come into contact or abrasion occurring with the mask otherwise the paintwork is likely going to suffer damage.
- The kigurumi mask must always be kept in a safe place. As it is susceptible to scratches and it is rigid, the mask should be kept in a place away from accidental contact. Place the mask upright when resting it on the ground. Do not keep plastics or newspaper in contact with the surface of the mask for prolonged periods of time to prevent staining.
- Visibility in the mask is low. Take time to familiarise and become comfortable with the mask on. Be aware that most users will find breathing slightly difficult when first using the mask. Start slow and get use to wearing it. When used outdoors, always have at least one handler assisting the mask user.

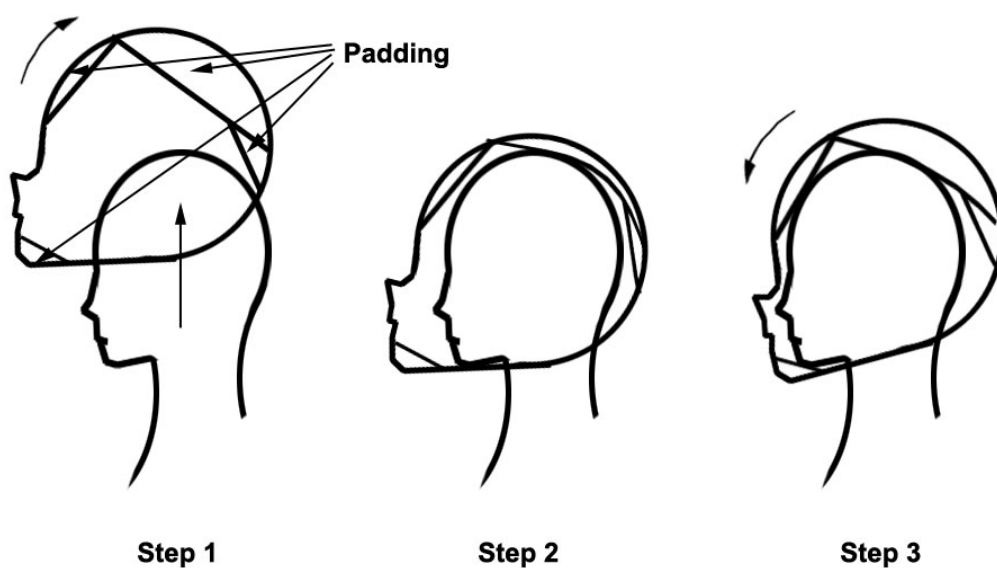
Mask maintenance

- The wig is attached onto the mask with Velcro strips. Extreme caution must be taken when attempting to remove the wig. Wigs can be removed for detangling, washing or replacement. As the Velcro may be very strong, avoid using too much force or it can be ripped off the mask. In the case that the Velcro falls off, re-attach the strip with strong glue (do not use superglue).
- Like all products, the mask is vulnerable to wear and tear. Depending on the amount of contact with the hands, the matt coating on the mask will eventually be worn away and the mask will become glossed. Simply obtain a can of matt coat aerosol spray and recoat the mask.
- If the eyes or brows are damaged due to accident or wear, print a new pair on a 4" x 6" gloss photo paper without border. Cut and re-attach the newly printed features. Mask owners will be given the images of the eyes upon request. Mask owners can change the eye and brow colours in the same procedure.
- Foam padding in the mask will eventually be flatten or worn out. They can be removed by force and new foam padding cut to the same shape can be re-attached with strong glue (do not use superglue). Increasing or decreasing the amount of padding can also be done in the same procedure.
- In the event of severe damage such as a crack, a chip, breakage or obvious scratch, the liability is on the mask owner to repair it by them self. The mask owner can contact the Wyu to obtain advice on repairing the mask if they wish to.

2. Product/package specifications

- The package includes:
 - A fully painted Anime-kao Kigurumi mask
 - Customised eyes and facial features.
 - Customised hair style, hair colour and hair length
- The mask is designed to be large enough to fit anyone, with minor exceptions.

The illustration below shows how to put on the mask.



Step 1: Fit the mask over the head by tilting it slightly backwards.

Step 2: Push the foam on the top of the head inwards to make room for the chin.

Step 3: Turn the mask forward and the chin rests on the foam below it. Eyes should look through the eye holes.

The mask should fit snugly and the mask should not swing freely when the head moves.

- The eye holes can be enlarged by using a needle file to increase the hole width.
- Should in an event the mask is too small or have severe fitting problems, please contact Wyu.

5. Terms and conditions

Article 2.1 Considerations

2.1.1 The effective term of this agreement is valid for the entire duration of the ownership of the Anime-kaō Kigurumi mask made by Wyu.

2.1.2 Users of the product must abide and act in accordance to the interest of the Anime-kaō Kigurumi culture described by Wyu in section 5, Anime-kaō Kigurumi culture on page 7 of this agreement.

2.1.3 The buyer is not to use or allow other parties to use the product for any activities with sexually offensive nature or having subject matters prohibited by law for populace under the age of 21.

2.1.4 Payment must be complete prior to commencement of the preparation of the final product.

Article 2.2 Copyright

2.2.1 All copyright of products and by products of the package covered by this agreement belongs to Wyu. The buyer shall not use and/or reproduce the product in any way without proper acknowledgements to Wyu. For the avoidance of doubt, the buyer is obliged to notify Wyu of activities where Wyu's work has been used.

2.2.2 In accordance to Article 2.2.1, Wyu will have access to copies of photographs of Wyu's work in any nature or setting as long as allowing this access does not:

- 1) misrepresents The buyer's contribution;
- 2) damages or disadvantages The buyer's competitive position; or
- 3) violates Wyu's obligations of confidentiality to the Client hereunder or in any other document.

2.2.3 The buyer agree to indemnify and hold Wyu harmless against any claims, actions, suits, damages, costs and expenses arising from exercising the copyright agreement with Wyu.

2.2.4 Wyu reserves the right of the use of the buyer's name (Article 2.5 Use of client's name) or information on the activities where the buyer uses the products and/or by products involved during this project.

2.2.5 The product's ownership is non transferable whether permanent or temporary to third parties without written approval by Wyu. Use of Wyu's product must be under the supervision of the buyer at all times.

Article 2.3 Liability

Other than anything stipulated in this agreement, the buyer receives no express or implied warranties. The buyer understands and agrees that any liability of Wyu regarding the services provided shall not include any special, consequential or punitive damages, any damages based on injury to person or property, or any lost sales or profits, or goods agreed outside this agreement.

Article 2.4 Confidential obligation

Both parties hereto shall use reasonable efforts to prevent third parties from learning about confidential and proprietary information, which includes without limitation technical information, methodologies, processes, programs, know-how and the contents of the deliverables, and disclose such confidential information only to he/she who have a need to know such information for the purpose to implement/perform the tasks connected to the nature of the product and use such information only for such purpose. These obligations do not apply to information or materials that:

- 1) are or become generally known by third parties other than as a result of an act or omission by the receiving party;
- 2) were already independently known by the receiving party prior to receiving them from the disclosing party;
- 3) are developed independently by the receiving party; or
- 4) are required by law or a governmental agency to be disclosed.

Article 2.5 Use of the client's name

Notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, Wyu shall have the right, upon the buyer's prior written approval, to reference The buyer and the general nature of the work on Wyu's web site and in presentations to prospects, clients or investors. If Wyu creates case studies, presentations, articles, and the like related to the project, Wyu shall notify the buyer, and discuss the conditions to the utilisation of the materials or contents thereof. In no event shall Wyu utilise the Materials or these rights in any way which:

- 1) misrepresents the buyer's contribution;
- 2) damages or disadvantages the buyer's competitive position; or
- 3) violates Wyu's obligations of confidentiality to the Client hereunder or in any other document.

Article 2.6 Entire agreement

This agreement constitutes the parties' entire agreement with respect to the subject matter contained herein, and supersedes all other prior written or oral agreements and undertakings with respect to such subject matter. The scope of this arrangement may be changed only by mutual consent.

Article 2.9 Non assignment

This agreement is personal to the the buyer and Wyu, and may not be assigned or otherwise transferred by any party hereto, in whole or part. Any attempted assignment of or attempt to assign this Agreement or any part thereof, whether by voluntary act or operation of law, shall be null and void.

6. Anime-kao Kigurumi culture

Anime-kao Kigurumi cosplayers have developed a culture of their own with the intention to protect their well being and also to establish a unique genre of cosplay. The culture is built from a number of practices that Anime-kao Kigurumi cosplayers adopt. Below will talk about how these practices provide protection for the cosplayers' well being and then illustrate that which makes this genre of cosplay unique. Other Anime-kao Kigurumi specific details will also be mentioned.

There are a couple of rules on how Anime-kao Kigurumi cosplayers should behave in order to protect their well being as well as to ensure the successfulness of their cosplay. The first rule will be not to speak whenever the cosplayer is in full costume and in the presence of the public. The main reason for doing so is to conceal the cosplayer's gender identity. This rule is important in order for Anime-kao Kigurumi to remain a gender independent form of cosplay. Another reason is that the voice of the masked cosplayer most definitely will not match that of the character that he/she is cosplaying as. Further still, since the facial feature of the mask does not move; having a voice will weaken the illusion of the realism of the character. To communicate when in cosplay, Anime-kao Kigurumi cosplayers have been seen to write on white boards or use signs.

The second rule is never to unmask in public. Anime-kao Kigurumi cosplayers have the right to protect their true identity. Removing the mask in public will also have a negative impact on the image of the character portrayed. Without this rule, Anime-kao Kigurumi cosplayers may have difficulty in refusing the public from demanding their masks to be taken off. As public behaviour is unpredictable, a bodyguard is necessary to protect the masked cosplayer from harassment as well as other difficulties which they may encounter. However Anime-kao Kigurumi cosplayers may choose to unmask to other Anime-kao Kigurumi cosplayers and friends when the public is not present.

Moving on, Anime-kao Kigurumi cosplay is unique to other cosplay for a few reasons. The first obvious difference is that a flesh coloured full bodysuit has to be worn on the Kigurumi cosplayer. The bodysuit will cover the cosplayer's body from toes to above the neck as a second layer of skin. This is in order to give the Kigurumi cosplayer's skin colour a uniform painted look which matches that of the mask. This also enhances the cosplayer's visual presentation of the entire cosplay. A matt toned flesh coloured bodysuit is selected to match the skin tone of typical anime figurines.

Another reason why Anime-kao Kigurumi is unique is because it is gender independent. As the Anime-kao Kigurumi cosplayer's face is covered by a mask, it is sometimes hard to tell the cosplayer's gender. This trait is further established since most of the successful Anime-kao Kigurumi cosplayer today cosplay as characters of a gender opposite to that of the cosplayer's. In the Anime-kao Kigurumi cosplayers' interest, the public are advised to appreciate the cosplay as they are presented.

Anime-kao Kigurumi cosplay has another very unique trait. As long as the cosplayer is wearing the flesh coloured bodysuit along with the mask, wearing any clothing at all is already as good as cosplaying. The effect is that it will look just like the portrayed character wearing the clothing. This makes Anime-kao Kigurumi cosplay very versatile in terms of finding a matching costume. Also, to portray specific characters wearing casual clothes has been close to impossible with conventional cosplay but with Anime-kao Kigurumi cosplay it is easy.

Having illustrated the general practices of Anime-kao Kigurumi there are still some points to note on Kigurumi as a hobby. To an Anime-kao Kigurumi cosplayer, private photo shoots can portray their character better than in a public photo shoot. Anime-kao Kigurumi requires the cosplayer to put on a mask which is in the form of a larger than real life head. This meant that when photographs are taken of the Kigurumi cosplayer and someone not in Kigurumi cosplay, the Kigurumi cosplayer will look abnormally large. To best show the beauty of an Anime-kao Kigurumi cosplay, photographs should not include anyone not in Kigurumi cosplay. Even said so, this is not a rule restricting Kigurumi cosplayer from taking pictures with people not in Kigurumi cosplay.

These cultural practices are founded by a small group of Anime-kao Kigurumi cosplayers who originate in Japan. With the increasing widespread of Anime-kao Kigurumi cosplay worldwide over the years, there are some who disregard the rules mentioned above. In order to preserve the culture and further strengthen the genre of cosplay, Anime-kao Kigurumi cosplayers are advised to abide to the rules as much as possible.

An advice for new Anime-kao Kigurumi cosplayers is to get used to wearing the mask. It is not advisable to take part in public events if the cosplayer is not used to wearing the mask while moving or standing. It risks breaking the rules mentioned above and it also endangers the Kigurumi cosplayer. For example, the Kigurumi cosplayer may not have enough endurance to keep the mask on for the entire duration of the exhibition or the Kigurumi cosplayer may trip and fall due to not being used to restricted vision.
